- Solid Colored Polo shirts with FCA on the front. Elementary may wear plain solid colored polos and/or polo dresses.
- Jeans: Blue, Black, Navy, Khaki, Gray in color. No rips or frays.
- Skirts and Shorts: Blue, Black, Navy, Khaki, Gray in color. Must be finger-tip length.
